- **Installing air conditioning units**
- **Fitting bathrooms**
- **Emergency call outs and repairs**
- **Central heating and gas or oil supply systems**
- **Above ground draining systems**
- **Installation and maintenance of heating systems**

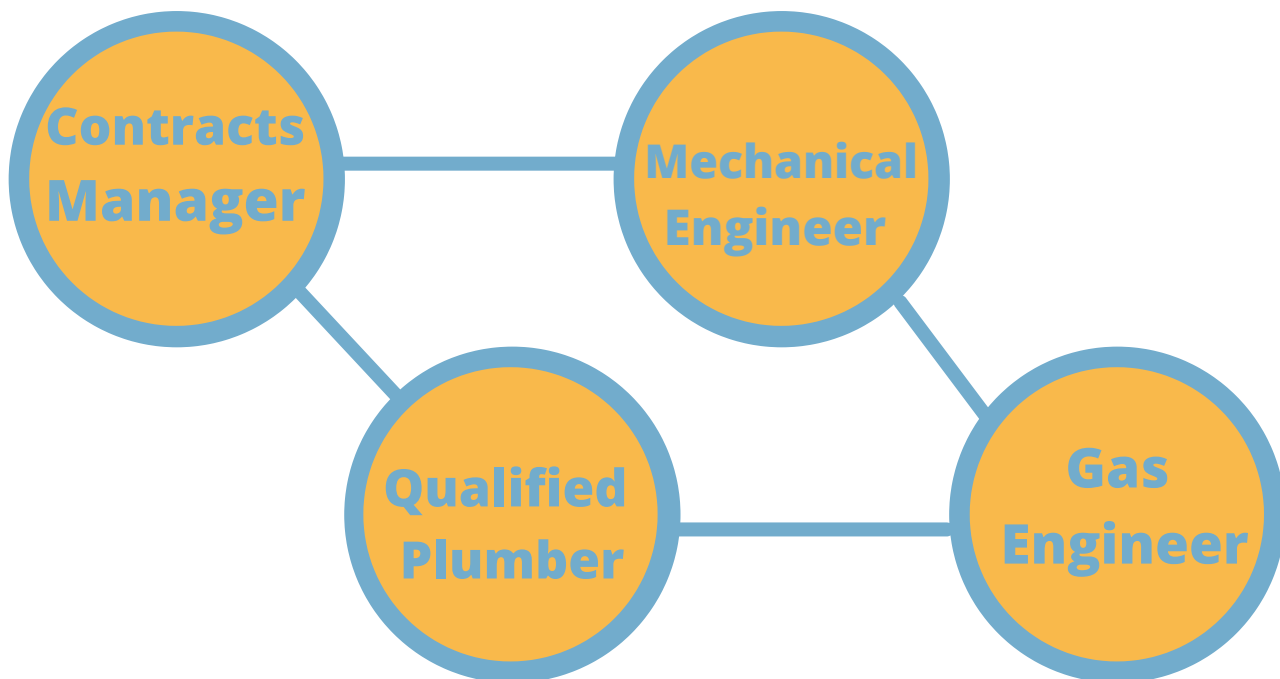
