









Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Hairdressing

The Level 2 Hairdressing is a newly created qualification based on employer needs and has been designed by employers for learners wishing to gain an apprenticeship within the Hair Professional arena. The Diploma will lead to the achievement of the Hair Professional Apprenticeship Standard alongside the relevant functional skills.

This a qualification is designed for learners who are at least 16 years old and who want to develop the skills and knowledge needed to begin to work as a Hairdresser. They may have previously completed a Level 1 qualification in the relevant subject area. Learners must complete these qualifications as an employed, apprentice in a real work environment.

What does the qualification cover?

The Diploma covers all of the core knowledge and skills needed to become a competent Hairdresser, providing the learner with the opportunity to develop different skills from a selection of optional units. This qualification also includes an element of End-Point Assessment (EPA) which is assessed by a City & Guilds Independent End-point Assessor.

What opportunities for progression are there?

Learners achieving the Diploma for Hair Professionals – Hairdressing can gain employment in a salon as a Hairdresser, carrying out day to day tasks such as:

- · customer service
- · shampooing hair
- cutting
- styling and finishing hair
- · colouring services

This Diploma will lead to the achievement of the

Hairdressing Professional Standard alongside the relevant functional skills.

To achieve the Level 2 Diploma for Hair Professionals - Hairdressing, learners must achieve 5 mandatory units, 201-205, 1 optional unit from 206-208 & achieve the end-point assessment.

Level 3 NVQ Diploma in Hairdressing

The Level 3 Diplomas/Awards in Hairdressing and Barbering are suitable for people who have taken a level 2 or level 3 qualifications, and/or have been working in the industry and are looking to accredit their skills and knowledge. These qualifications provide progression opportunities for those with intentions of progressing into employment or onto an NVQ/SVQ level 3 qualification.

A minimum of 58 credits is required to achieve the Level 3 Diploma in Women's Hairdressing. All mandatory units must be achieved which is 48 credits and a minimum of 10 credits from the optional units. The recommended GLH is 493 hours.


